



Dear Grade 5 Parents of 2025

The following is a list of stationery requirements for the 2025 school year. It is imperative that the children have the required stationery when they return to school at the start of the year. I will place a note in your child's homework book as and when additional stationery is needed.

At the beginning of 2025, each child will receive a starter pack of stationery items, **PROVIDED BY SCHOOL**. They will also receive all the necessary exercise books. The starter pack includes:

- 2 x Blue ballpoint pen
- 2 x HB pencils
- Eraser
- 1 x 36g glue stick
- All books
- 1 x 30cm ruler
- 1 x Metal sharpener
- 1 x Highlighter
- 10 x Plastic sleeves
- 2 x A4 PVC carry folders
- 1 x Exam pad
- 1 x whiteboard marker

It is recommended that your child also have the following stationery items, **SUPPLIED BY YOU**, for the year.

- (6 x 6192) 6 spare ballpoint blue pens
- (6 x 6270) 6 spare HB pencils
- (2 x 6326) 2 x spare eraser (Mon Ami dust free)
- (6169) 1 x scissors
- (1 x 6531) 1 x kokis
- (1 x 6352) 1 x coloured pencils
- (1 x 6603) 3 x highlighters
- (2 x 6132) 2 x spare glue sticks (please label with your child's name, these will be kept by the teacher)
- (1 x 6412) 1 x spare sharpener
- (6418/6438) Space case or pencil case big enough to fit all stationery
- Precut 12 x A4 book covers (of your own choice)
- (3 x 6094) 18 x A4 plastic covers
- Precut 3 x A5 book covers (of your own choice)
- (1 x 6115) Labels for all books (only if no label space provided on book covers themselves)
- (1 x 6103) 3 x A5 plastic covers
- 2 x Boxes of tissues
- Headphones/earphones to use during computer lessons (not Bluetooth)
- Please note: The children (especially boarders) will be required to cover their own books. Every book requires a plastic cover. Please supply precut book and plastic covers; sufficient sellotape and labels, these are all a necessity.
